

I LIMP AND I CLING

Genesis 32:24-32

3 Gifts: a limp, a new name, a blessing.

TAKE-AWAYS:

- Good things happen when you get alone with God.
- A misapplied character trait is redeemable.
- In the fight, resistance to is transformed into desperation to receive from.
- God wants to give you a new name – a new identity.

- A limp is part of the pathway to our destiny.

A “limp” is anything that causes or reminds you to depend on God.

We like to project to others we don't have a limp.

2 Corinthians 12:7-10

If you don't admit and embrace your limp, there is no room for Christ to become your Source of Life.

- *Acedia* (one of the seven deadly sins) = spiritual boredom or apathy.

A symptom of *acedia* is you don't engage.

- Your circumstances may not change – but God will change you as you limp and cling.
