## 4 Leadership / Influencing Choices

# 1

He chose to not get caught up in the fear and anxiety that he was surrounded by. Instead, he remains grounded in the larger, big-picture plan that God is working out.

- When fear and anxiety rise -- our memory of the past diminishes.
- God purposefully was teaching a new way of life.

# 2

He resisted taking the easy, short-sighted path to keep everybody happy. Instead he courageously does what is best and what is right – even if it meant he would do it alone.

# 3

He chose to not react or rush. And, he chose to balance – there is a time to sit still, and there is a time to move.

- There is no need to be panic or anxiety driven.
- Jesus was tempted to rush in the wilderness – but refused. Matthew 4:1-11
- When we move quickly, when we react, we are usually trying to avoid or bypass something.
- “Stand”, “see”, “keep silent”. v.13-14
- A crisis is not a crisis unless you don't know what to do.

He chose to not remain paralyzed, helpless or overwhelmed. Instead, he takes action and fulfills his role to move God's people forward . . . God's way!
